School Medication Policy

Kindly review the MHS Medication policy:

Student's medications should be given at home if possible. Medication will only be given during school hours by complying with the following guidelines:

- 1. Medication consent form must be completed and signed.**
- 2. Medications must be in the original container.**
- 3. The office will only dispense medication to students when there are complete written directions from the parents attached to the medication (indicating exact time and dosage either in writing or on ClassDojo).**
- 4. Parents need to notify classroom teacher on ClassDojo that the medication is in the student's bag.**
- 5. Medication bottles will be sent home at the end of day or when the medication course is completed, or the medication has expired.**
- 6. All communication is through your classroom teacher on ClassDojo and not through the Admin office by phone.**
